Directions:

It has been said that stories can change our lives. These stories – fiction or nonfiction – could be ones you have read in a book, a newspaper, on-line, or stories that have been told to you. Think of a story that has had an important impact on your life or on the life of someone you know.

Write about the theme: An Important Story

Do **one** of the following:

Retell the story briefly and then describe the impact it has had on your life or on the life of someone you know.

OR

Tell about an important life lesson that could be learned from a story. Briefly retell the story.

OR

Persuade your readers that one's success in life could depend on learning lessons from an important story. Use specific examples from your own life or the life of someone you know.

OR

> Write about the theme in your own way.

Use examples from real life, from what you have read or watched, or from your imagination. Mind the GAP: genre, audience, purpose.

Use your brainstorm. Make sure you double-space your story. You should give careful thought to revision (rethinking ideas) and editing (correcting spelling, capitalization, and punctuation).
